What is a temperature excursion?

Answer: Any temperature that falls outside of the CDC and vaccine manufacturer's recommended ranges is considered a temperature excursion.

Fraud is an intentional deception or misrepresentation made by a person that could result in an unauthorized benefit.

Abuse is any provider practice that is inconsistent with sound fiscal, business, or medical practice.

What are two examples of Fraud or Abuse that are common in the VFC program?

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A Digital Data Logger (DDL) is an electronic temperature monitoring device that records temperature data over time using a built-in sensor or external sensor.

What must every DDL have to be current and valid?

Answer: Every DDL must have a current and valid Certificate of Calibration.

Answer: Medicaid- eligible, Uninsured, Underinsured, American Indian or Alaskan Native

Underinsured children are *only* eligible to receive VFC vaccine where?

Answer: Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC)

Who is eligible to be a VFC/317 Medical Director?

Answer: A licensed Medical Doctor (MD) or Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO) in New Jersey authorized to administer vaccines to children aged 18 years and younger for VFC, and to adults 19 and older for 317

A child has Medicaid as a secondary insurance. Are they eligible to receive VFC vaccine? If so, what are the options for billing?

DOUBLE JEOPARDY

Answer: Medicaid as Secondary Insurance: The provider can administer VFC vaccines and bill Medicaid for the administration fee or the provider can administer private stock vaccines and bill the primary insurance carrier for both the cost of the vaccine and the administration fee.

What does NJIIS stand for?

Answer: New Jersey Immunization Information System

What must be done by the provider in NJIIS within 30 days of administering VFC vaccines?

Answer: Each administered dose of VFC vaccine must be entered into NJIIS within 30 days of administration.

How often do providers have to update their minimum/maximum temperatures in NJIIS?

Answer: Bi-weekly. Temperatures must be submitted to NJIIS on the 1st and 15th of every month.

What is the correct NJIIS vaccine transaction for unopened vaccines that have been spoiled due to a temperature excursion and deemed non-viable by VFC/317?

Answer: Expired and Spoiled Transaction

Vaccines that are expired must be returned to where within six months?

Answer: Expired and spoiled vaccines must be returned to McKesson within six months of the spoilage or expiration date.

What population is Nirsevimab recommended for?

Answer: Nirsevimab is recommended for all infants younger than 8 months during their first RSV season and some children (ages 8 through 19 months) who are at increased risk for severe RSV disease and entering their second RSV season.

Answer: Pneumococcal vaccine (PCV15, PCV20, Prevnar 20, and Vaxneuvance)

What is a cold chain?

Answer: A cold chain is a temperature-controlled supply chain that includes all vaccine-related equipment and procedures.

Answer: Enrollment site visit, Compliance site visit, Storage and handling site visit (scheduled and unannounced)

Answer: Lot number and number of doses received should match the packing slip and NJIIS.

Answer: A qualified container and pack out and a DDL.
